This excursion combines visits to two of Denmark's most famous castles. From Copenhagen through the landscape of North Zealand your first visit is to **Frederiksborg Castle**, built in Renaissance style in 1615 by King Christian IV. A unique castle and today the museum of national Danish history, housing collections of furniture, paintings of the royal members of the family since the 16<sup>th</sup> century and silverware. The visit includes the museum with its treasures, and the castle chapel.

Proceed to **Fredensborg Palace**, the Queen's summer and autumn residence, situated in a beautiful park on the edge of Lake Esrum. A short drive to the town of Elsinore for a visit to **Kronborg Castle** originally built in 1420 and known by Shakespeare's play "Hamlet". Visit the catacombs where you will find **Holger Dansk** or Logier the Dane. The legend has it that he never lost a battle in his life – according to the legend, if Denmark at some point in time should have its sovereignty threatened, Holger will once more awake and do battle for Denmark. We return to Copenhagen along the "Danish Riviera" with a lovely view of the Danish and Swedish coasts. Lunch will be served en route.
