Day 6 : Myvatn and Akureyri Summer

You will be making your way to the North of Iceland today, right across the large and beautiful expanse of **Vatnajökull National Park**. Your first stop of the day will be the magnificent Dettifoss waterfall, the most powerful in Europe.

Your next destination is the varied and dynamic **Mývatn area**, named after the lake ('Midge Lake'). This area is known for its energetic geothermal activity and you will get to see this first hand at the **Námskarð** area where these forces rise to the surface through steaming mud puddles and fumaroles.

You will then head to the 'Capital of the North', **Akureyri**. Before you cross the mountain pass to get there, however, you will make a quick stop at the waterfall, **Goðafoss**. This is a historically famous site in which the old idols of the pagan religion were cast into the water as an act of fealty towards the Christian faith.

Winter

A visit to **Námaskarð** pass, a high-temperature geothermal area where the earth boils and gurgles. The orange and red landscape in the area shows how versatile Icelandic nature can be.

Dimmuborgir, your next stop is where you will explore a field of peculiarly shaped lava pillars that rise from the earth and their formations may remind you of trolls, elves and other mythical creatures, even the Icelandic Yule Lads.

Your next destination is the varied and dynamic Mývatn area, named after the lake ('Midge Lake'), you will get to see this first hand at the Námskarð area where these forces rise to the surface through steaming mud puddles and fumaroles.

You will then head to the 'Capital of the North', Akureyri. Before you cross the mountain pass to get there, however, you will make a quick stop at the waterfall, Goðafoss.

You will then head further south to the Hvitserkur area. Hvitserkur is an intriguing rock formation that is often referred to as the 'Troll of Northwest Iceland.' It stands 15 metres tall in the Hunafloi Bay. Local legends say that this formation was once a troll who stayed out too late and when the sun came up, was turned to stone. Today Hvitserkur is one of the most photographed attractions in Northern Iceland and you will quickly see why.



Day 2: South Coast Tour Day 1

Skógafoss is an incredibly picturesque sight. Alongside the gorge, a staircase can take you to the shelf above the waterfall for stunning views. See if you can count your steps on your way up.

The Seljalandsfoss, the adventure begins when your arrival is announced by the powerful theatrics of Seljalandsfoss. Bring a raincoat and you'll be able to make the short hike behind the falls.

Glacier Hike in Skaftafell we will hike an outlet glacier spawning from the largest glacier in the country, Vatnajökull. After meeting our highly trained glacier guides and strapping on your safety and glacier equipment, including helmets, harnesses, crampons, and ice axes we hike on the ice for an hour and a half. A spectacular experience and an opportunity to learn more about this breathtaking and increasingly rare natural phenomena.

Blue Ice Cave during winter, The journey continues with the blue ice cave exploration, we recommend wearing waterproof hiking boots that cover your ankles and have a hard sole. Your guide will share with you his expertise about the ice caves, allowing you to truly appreciate this amazing natural phenomenon – spoiler alert... it will be blue.

Day 3 : South Coast Tour Day 2

Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon - Starting this day by heading to Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon, a 200m deep glacial lagoon fed by Breiðamerkurjökull, an outlet glacier of Europe's largest glacier. We will allow you to book a boat ride between the icebergs during summertime and get a closer look at the millenary ice. If boating is not your thing, then we walk alongside the glacier lagoon enjoying the magnificent views and dead silence of Icelandic nature.

Diamond Beach - On the other side of the road the icebergs from the Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon float into the Atlantic Ocean where they are quickly thrown back to shore by the tide and winds. This black sand beach is full of smaller ice rocks in all shapes and sizes, sparkling like diamonds in the daylight. The ice itself comes in all shades of white and blue forming beautiful contrasts, guaranteed to make your Instagram account pop!

Reynisfjara, the Black Sand Beach, is the place where the massive waves of the Atlantic meet the unique basalt columns in the cliffs above the sand. This area of the south is also a paradise for bird lovers, as Puffins and dozens of other unique species are found here from June to August.

Day 4: Golden Circle

Pingvellir National Park - we visit the place where the two tectonic plates, the North American and the Eurasian plate, are moving away from each other. The biggest natural lake in Iceland is also located at Thingvellir National Park and hosts a great variety of fish and birdlife.

This Icelandic family-run business sticks to traditional Icelandic farming culture and focuses on cows and cattle breeding. You will be able to enjoy their tasty farm-to-table dairy products, see the stunning mountain view and see the friendly animals. We will invite you to taste the ice cream yourself and meanwhile watch the animals relaxing in the stable.







Day 5: Reykjavik City Tour & Aurora Hunting

Take a bus tour with City Sightseeing and explore Reykjavík at your leisure, with the opportunity to hop on and off at conveniently located bus stops. This bus pass is valid for 24 hours so you take your time to enjoy a full day of Reykjavík. It's a city that boasts the best of both worlds; a modern, trendy, and forward-looking capital whilst at the same time being so close to its unspoiled nature. Reykjavík truly is a magical place to behold.

In the evening, you will go on a aurora hunting tour (September - March). Seeing the northern lights weaving their way across the night sky is a captivating experience.

Day 6: Vikings on the West Coast

You will go from Reykjavík to exploring lava fields, waterfalls, lava caves, white and black beaches and much more. On your way from Reykjavík you will drive along mount Esja that looks over the whole city of Reykjavík. Soon you will enter the scenic fjord of Hvalfjörður (whale fjord). Once you are out of Hvalfjörður you will enter another fjord, Borgarfjörður.

The first attraction of the day is Europe's most powerful hot spring, Deildartunguhver, where bailing water is bubbling from the ground, you will feel the heat from the hot steam. Next stop is Reykholt, one of the most important historical locations in Iceland. This was the home of Snorri Sturluson who was one of the most significant figures of the Middle Ages. After leaving Reykholt you will see two waterfalls, Hraunfossar and Barnafoss. Hraunfossar is a series of rivulets that stream through the dark lava field. Barnafoss waterfall is a light blue waterfall that rushes through a narrow gorge.

You will stay the night in Borgarfjörður area. Since this is a winter tour, you will have a chance of experiencing the northern lights if the weather and northern lights forecast allows

Day 7: A Journey to the Centre of the Earth

Today you will explore the magical peninsula Snæfellsnes. The first stop of the day will be Gerðuberg cliffs, from there you will go to Ytri-Tunga white sand beach. White beaches are not common in Iceland so this is a really interesting stop. Then it's off to Arnarstapi with its magical coastline. This area is surrounded by basalt ravines and caves, you can see the Atlantic ocean rushing against the dramatic cliffs.

Next stop will be Djúpalónssandur, black pebble beach. Yo get to the beach you will have to walk through a maze of free standing lava pillars.

Throughout the day you will have Snæfellsjökull glacier watching over you. Snæfellsjökull was used as the entrance to the center of the earth in Jules Verne's classic sci-fi novel. You will actually have the chance of entering the center of the earth through Vatnshellir cave if you fancy.

The last but not at all least stop of the day is the most photographed mountain in Iceland, Kirkjufell. On your way back to Reykjavík, you will drive through a stunning fjord called Hraunsfjörður where you will see the dark lava field of Berserkjahraun lava field. On your way back make sure to keep an eye on the sky as you might be able to experience the magical northern lights along the way back to the city.

Day 8 : Free at leisure

You can choose to add-on activities on this day as you wish.

Day 5: The Eastfjords

Today you will be exploring the beautiful and remote Eastfjords. Travelling through mountainous passes with the ocean to your left, your guide will make a number of stops along these meandering passages. As well as being known for its dramatic fjords, this area is characterised by its breathtaking beaches, littered with multi-coloured pebbles and rocks.

Your guide will introduce you to small-town life out in the countryside before heading to the central 'hub' of the East, Egilsstaðir. As well as being the largest town in the Eastfjords, it is also close to the largest forest in Iceland, Hallormsstaðaskógar and the lake Lagafljót in which a legendary water monster is said to reside.

Day 6 : Myvatn and Akureyri Summer

You will be making your way to the North of Iceland today, right across the large and beautiful expanse of Vatnajökull National Park. Your first stop of the day will be the magnificent Dettifoss waterfall, the most powerful in Europe.

Your next destination is the varied and dynamic Mývatn area, named after the lake ('Midge Lake'). This area is known for its energetic geothermal activity and you will get to see this first hand at the Námskarð area where these forces rise to the surface through steaming mud puddles and

You will then head to the 'Capital of the North', Akureyri. Before you cross the mountain pass to get there, however, you will make a quick stop at the waterfall, Goðafoss. This is a historically famous site in which the old idols of the pagan religion were cast into the water as an act of fealty towards the Christian faith.

Winter

A visit to Námaskarð pass, a high-temperature geothermal area where the earth boils and gurgles. The orange and red landscape in the area shows how versatile Icelandic nature can be.

Dimmuborgir, your next stop is where you will explore a field of peculiar shaped lava pillars that rise from the earth and their formations may remind you of trolls, elves and other mythical creatures, even the Icelandic Yule Lads.

Your next destination is the varied and dynamic Mývatn area, named after the lake ('Midge Lake'), you will get to see this first hand at the Námskarð area where these forces rise to the surface through steaming mud puddles and fumaroles.

You will then head to the 'Capital of the North', Akureyri. Before you cross the mountain pass to get there, however, you will make a quick stop at the waterfall, Goðafoss.

Day 7: Exploring North Iceland

Today you will head back to where your journey began. You can explore the town of Akureyri or take in some final extra adventures.

From here you will catch a whale watching tour. You will hop aboard a boat in the local harbour and head out to spot these gentle giants.

You will then head further south to the Hvitserkur area. Hvitserkur is an intriguing rock formation that is often referred to as the 'Troll of Northwest Iceland.' It stands 15 metres tall in the Hunafloi Bay. Local legends say that this formation was once a troll who stayed out too late and when the sun came up, was turned to stone. Today Hvitserkur is one of the most photographed attractions in Northern Iceland and you will quickly see why.

Day 8 : Snæfellsnes peninsula

One of the peninsula's most iconic sites is the 'mountain like an arrowhead', Kirkjufell, made famous from Season 7 of HBO's Game of Thrones. As the town landmark of Grundarfjörður, Kirkjufell is found on the peninsula's northern shore and holds the title as Iceland's "most photographed mountain" due to its unique and striking aesthetic.

You'll next make a visit to the black sand beach of Djúpalónssandur, found at the base of Snæfellsjökull glacier. Once a popular fishing village and port, Djúpalónssandur now lays deserted, save for the four famed lifting stones that, throughout history, have been used a test of strength among local fishermen.





If you want to spice up your day, you could choose to explore Vatnshellir lava tube, an 8000-year-old cave situated 35-metres under the ground. Visitors here will descend a metallic staircase, revealing a 200-metre long subterranean world filled with intricate rock formations and captivating colour shades.

Day 9: The West

You will begin by leaving Borganes and you will make your first stop in the Reykholtsdalur Valley. This is a place that demonstrates the powerful geothermal forces that have shaped Iceland. This area is the home of Europe's most powerful hot spring, Deildartunguhver.

You will then head to the village of Reykholt. This place was the home of Snorri Sturluson. Snorri was a noted Icelandic poet, historian and lawspeaker who lived during the middle ages. His work is considered an invaluable record of the Old Norse mythology and language.

You will also make a stop at two incredible waterfalls. Barnafoss and Hraunfossar. Hraunfossar is fed by underground water that soaks through the pores of lava rock. Barnafoss pushes its way through a narrow gorge.
